#### **Information about the class:**

Learn about the stages of portraiture, drawing with charcoal from a live model. Students are taught about proportion, the structure of the head, and tonal values. Experiment with creating contrast between light and dark (chiaroscuro) to depict facial features. Suitable for all levels of experience.

#### **Aims and objectives:**

Looking at the portrait and breaking it down into bite sized chunks. Learning how to implement techniques which can be used across all disciplines to capture a portrait. Focusing on, facial structures, noses, eyes and mouths.

#### **Materials or clothing required and any additional costs:**

Materials are included. Please note it is advisable to wear old clothing.

#### **Tutor biography:**

Chris's practice focuses on figure, manipulation and viewer authorship. It is the narratives that the audience create that motivates him to produce.
